## I. Requirements for all scholarships:

1. A minimum GPA of 3.5 in the major and a minimum GPA of 3.0 overall.
2. Copy of college transcripts.
3. Application letter describing your academic goals and achievements, in English. One page max please. Where relevant, please address specific eligibility requirements.
4. **One** letter of recommendation. One page max please. (excluding members of the Scholarship Committee: Professors Michel Lantelme (chair), Luis Cortest, Takeshi Kimoto, Bob Lemon and Marcelo Rioseco)

Note: **Please ensure your recommender includes an email address and phone number.**

## II. Awards: Award amounts vary. All awards are merit-based and/or dependent upon financial need.

1. **James Abbott Scholarship** Graduate students in **Spanish**.
2. **Patricio Gimeno Memorial Award** Senior **Spanish** major with the highest GPA in Spanish courses required for the major.
3. **Poston-De La Torre Award** **Spanish** majors with junior or senior standing.
4. **The Lupita Thompson Scholarship** Language major in the **certification** program or **Spanish** major who has completed at least 24 hours of class work in the major language.
5. **Eulalia Steedman Aroz Endowed Scholarship**  
Full-time, regularly enrolled **Spanish** major, with a minimum 3.6 GPA. Must have demonstrated financial need. Must be a native Oklahoman.

- 6. Besse Clement Loan Fund** Based on merit and financial need. All full-time graduate or undergraduate majors of **French** are eligible. The award amount will equal at least twice the average full-time, in-state tuition.
- 7. Julia Kathryn Gilbert Memorial Award** Undergraduate juniors or seniors with a major or minor in **French**.
- 8. Andrew Talton Scholarship** For students with an emphasis in **French**.
- 9. Ivar Ivask Scholarship** Students majoring in **German** or **French**.
- 10. Tulsa German Fund** Graduate students in **German**.
- 11. OU German Club Award** Undergraduate students with at least 2 years of **German**.
- 12. Madland-Thompson German Award** Undergraduate students with at least 2 years of **German**.
- 13. Müller-Miess Memorial Award** **German** major or minor with at least 2 years of **German**.
- 14. Peter Brueckner Award** **German** major or minor with at least 2 years of **German**.
- 15. Gerlinde Miess Thompson Memorial Scholarship in German Studies** **German** major or minor with at least 2 years of **German**.
- 16. Russian Club Award** Any **Russian** major or minor currently enrolled in at least the third semester of Russian and who will have continued enrollment in Russian during the scholarship tenure.
- 17. Nikolai Antsiferov Award** **Russian** majors, particularly students who plan to pursue a career in teaching. Special consideration is given to students who intend to study abroad.
- 18. Cankun and Ming Chao Gui Memorial Award** **Chinese** major or minor with at least 2 years of Chinese, with the highest GPA.
- 19. Dorothy and John Bernard Faust Award** **Linguistics** undergraduate major.
- 20. Owen Hartley Faust Award** Students pursuing a major or minor in **Modern Non-European Languages**, and have completed two years in the language (Arabic, Chinese, Japanese, Hebrew).
- 21. Jim Artman Award** Any Modern Languages major or minor.
- 22. Lowell and Frances Dunham Scholarship** Any Modern Languages major, undergraduate (with at least sophomore standing) or graduate student.
- 23. Olive Hawes Scholarship** Any Modern Languages major, undergraduate (with at least junior standing) or graduate student.
- 24. Mary Enod Williams Memorial Scholarship** Any Modern Languages major, undergraduate (with at least junior standing) or graduate student.
- 25. Hazel Brakebill Perreault Scholarship** Any Modern Languages major with at least sophomore standing.
- 26. McMillan Memorial Fund Scholarship** Any Modern Languages or Linguistics major with junior standing.
- 27. Melvin B. Tolson, Jr. Scholarship** Any Modern Languages or Linguistics undergraduate major with an overall GPA of 4.0.

**All awards will be announced at the Kappa Gamma Epsilon and Modern Languages, Literatures, and Linguistics Awards Reception to be held on April 23, 2015.**
